Minor puppy class	correctly inoculated puppies up to 6 months
Puppy class	6 - 9 months

Open class	from 15 months
Working class	from 15 months (Please enclose to entry form copy of working certificate)
Champion class	from 15 months (Please enclose to entry form copy of champion certificate)
Veteran class	from 8 years
Honor class	from 15 months, available for dogs with the title ICH, CH, Club winner (Please enclose to entry form copy of champion certificate)

COMPETITIONS

Best Couple – An owner (100% same owners on both dogs) can enter his dog and bitch, that have been judged at this show.

Breeder's group – A breeder can enter his breeding group of at least 3 dogs or bitches, which have been judged at this show. The dogs don't have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from his kennel, from different litters, at least from 2 different dams or sires. A dog/bitch can only be entered to one breeder's group.

Junior handling – the exhibitor can enter a junior handler and their dog to this competition, the dog does not have to be entered to the show. The competition has two age categories, from 9 to 13 years old and from 14 to 17 years old.

Child and dog – age category of the handler: from 3 to 8 years old.

TITLES AND CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES

CAJC – Certificate for the Junior Champion title of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 1st in junior class

CAC – Certificate for the Champion of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded Excellent 1st in intermediate, open, working or champion class

Reserve CAC – may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 2st in intermediate, open, working or champion class

Winner of the Minor Puppy Specialty Show – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded Very Promising 1

Winner of the Puppy Specialty Show – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded Very Promising 1

Winner of the Junior Specialty Show – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded CAJC.

Winner of the Specialty Show – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded CAC. The best dog and best bitch will be awarded with this title.

Winner of the Veteran Specialty Show - awarded to the dog and bitch in veteran class graded Excellent 1

BOB - to the competition proceeds winners of Specialty Show, Junior Specialty Show and Veteran Specialty Show.

BOS – Best of Opposite Sex

The dogs whose owners are not members of the club cannot compete for the title Winner of the Specialty Show.

The entry to the pedigree will be after the judging.

VETERINARY REGULATIONS

Dogs from abroad must have a PET PASSPORT with valid vaccinations.

PROTESTS

A protest can only be submitted for formal reasons, in writing form, in the show office, at the time of the show until the judging in the ring is finished, against a deposit 35 euro, which will be forfeit in case the decision of the committee is unfounded. Protest against any decision made by judge – grade, placement, titles, etc., is not allowed.

GENERAL PROVISION

The show is organized according to the regulations of the FCI and SKJ and the regulations issued by the organizer. Only dogs registered with the stud books recognized by the FCI can enter the show.

It is not possible to change the class on the day of the show! The organizer may refuse to accept the application without stating the reason.

The organizer cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog. The owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog. A judge is obliged to disqualify aggressive dogs. Provoking dogs against each other is not allowed. It is forbidden to prepare a dog with any substance that will alter the structure, color or form of the coat, skin or nose. Only trimming, clipping, combing and brushing are allowed. Double handling from outside of the ring is forbidden. It is strictly forbidden to leave dogs tied up on trimming tables except the time they are being prepared for the show (trimmed, brushed or combed). Violation of these rules will result in disqualifying the dog from the competition.

Selling puppies at the exhibition grounds is strictly forbidden!

The exhibitors are responsible for safeguarding and the welfare of the dogs at dog shows. It is forbidden to put the dog in a situation that can be dangerous for its health and welfare, such as leaving it in the car in hot or cold weather and/or treating it in a cruel manner. Violation of these rules will result in exclusion from the ongoing and future dog shows. The judges are judging the dogs according to the valid standards issued by the FCI. The judge is allowed to refuse to judge a dog that is late for his class. The judge is obliged to refuse to judge a dog, whose owner is not able to provide the dog's pedigree when asked by the ring steward.

Moving a dog from open class to working or champion class at the show is not possible. Moving a dog from class to class at the show is only possible in case of organizer's mistake.

Fill in a separate form for each dog! A copy of the FCI pedigree, the recognized Champion title for Champion class and an International working certificate for Working class must be included! All Entry forms to Working class or Winner class without FCI-Working certificate or without confirmed champion title will be automatically transferred to Open class.

The entry of the dog will be confirmed 5 days before the show by e-mail.

The organizer is not responsible for incorrectly filled entry forms.
