COMPETITIONS

Best Brace – An owner can enter his dog and bitch that have been judged at this show. The owner must be stated on the pedigree.

Best Breeder's Group – A breeder can enter his breeder's group of at least 3 dogs or bitches, which have been judged at this show. The dogs don't have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from the same kennel from at least two different litters, at least twodifferent sires and dams.

Junior handling – the exhibitor can enter a junior handler and their dog to this competition, the dog does not have to be entered to the show. The competition has two age categories, from 9 to 13 years old and from 14 to 17 years old.

Child and dog – age category of the handler: from 3 to 8 years old.

TITLES AND CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES

CAJC SR – Certificate for the Junior Champion title of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 1st in junior class

CAC SR– Certificate for the Champion of Slovakia may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded Excellent 1st in intermediate, open, working or champion class

Reserve CAC SR – may be awarded to dogs and bitches graded as Excellent 2st in intermediate, open, working or champion class

CC - Certificate Club is awarded to dogs and bitches especially in the middle, open, working and champion classes at exhibitions organized by the Club of Beagle Breeders of Slovakia. CC can be awarded to a dog and a bitch with the award Excellent 1, CC is not claimable and is awarded at the show by an officially delegated judge only for exceptional qualities of the individual. CC can also be awarded to an individual who has already won the title of Club Champion

Winner of the Junior Specialty Show – awarded to a dog and a bitch with the CAJC SR award in the junior class.

Winner of the Specialty Show – dogs and bitches who have won the CAC award in the intermediate, open, working and champion classes advance to the competition. The best dog and the best bitch will be awarded this title.

Winner of the Veteran Specialty Show - awarded to the dog and bitch in veteran class graded Excellent 1

Best of Breed (BOB) – awarded to the best individual of the breed, individuals with the CAJC title, Winner of a special show and veteran with the award excellent 1 enter this competition

Best of Opposite sex (BOS) - individuals of the opposite sex enter the competition as the winner of the breed (BOB) with the award CAJC, the winner of the special show and the veteran with the award excellent 1

Best Minor Puppy – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded Very Promising 1 from minor puppy class

Best Puppy – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded Very Promising 1 from puppy class

Best of Veteran (BOV) – to the competition proceeds awarded dog and bitch, graded Excellent 1 from veteran class

The entry to the pedigree will be after the judging.

VETERINARY REGULATIONS

Dogs from abroad must have a PET PASSPORT with valid vaccinations.

PROTESTS

A protest can only be submitted for formal reasons, in writing form, in the show office, at the time of the show until the judging in the ring is finished, against a deposit 35 euro, which will forfeit in case the decision of the committee is unfounded. Protest against any decision made by judge – grade, placement, titles, etc., is not allowed.

GENERAL PROVISION

The show is organized according to the regulations of the FCI and SKJ and the regulations issued by the organizer. Only dogs registered with the stud books recognized by the FCI can enter the show.

It is not possible to change the class on the day of the show! The organizer may refuse to accept the application without stating the reason.

The organizer cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog. The owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog. A judge is obliged to disqualify aggressive dogs. Provoking dogs against each other is not allowed. It is forbidden to prepare a dog with any substance that will alter the structure, color or form of the coat, skin or nose. Only trimming, clipping, combing and brushing are allowed. Double handling from outside of the ring is forbidden. It is strictly forbidden to leave dogs tied up on trimming tables except the time they are being prepared for the show (trimmed, brushed or combed). Violation of these rules will result in disqualifying the dog from the competition.

Selling puppies at the exhibition grounds is strictly forbidden!

The exhibitors are responsible for safeguarding and the welfare of the dogs at dog shows. It is forbidden to put the dog in a situation that can be dangerous for its health and welfare, such as leaving it in the car in hot or cold weather and/or treating it in a cruel manner. Violation of these rules will result in exclusion from the ongoing and future dog shows. The judges are judging the dogs according to the valid standards issued by the FCI. The judge is allowed to refuse to judge a dog that is late for his class. The judge is obliged to refuse to judge a dog, whose owner is not able to provide the dog's pedigree when asked by the ring steward.

Moving a dog from open class to working or champion class at the show is not possible. Moving a dog from class to class at the show is only possible in case of organizer's mistake.

Fill in a separate form for each dog! A copy of the FCI pedigree, the recognized Champion title for Champion class and an International working certificate for Working class must be included! All Entry forms to Working class or Winner class without FCI-Working certificate or without confirmed champion title will be automatically transferred to Open class.

The entry of the dog will be confirmed 5 days before the show by e-mail.

The organizer is not responsible for incorrectly filled entry forms.

Please pay the entry fees only after you register online. Do not forget to mention the variable symbol in your payment information. Every entry form must include a clearly readable copy of dog's pedigree. Any other documents (puppy card, matrika, etc.) are accepted ONLY for minor puppy and puppy class!

You will find all the needed payment data (bank account, amount to pay and a variable symbol) with your sent entry form in the online system. The closing date is also the deadline to pay the entry fee within the given closing date.

It is compulsory to pay the entry fee within 24 hours after submitting the entry. Unpaid entries are automatically cancelled after 7 days without prior notice. The entry fees that would not be on the account latest on the closing date would be considered unpaid. Each exhibitor must state the variable symbol. For foreign payments, state the variable symbol in the information column. It is not needed to send a copy of payment, the payment is identified by the variable symbol only.

By submitting the entry of his/her dog the exhibitor is obliged to abide by the SKJ/FCI show regulations and Slovak veterinary rules. The exhibitor is giving his/ her permission to publish his/her adress in the exhibition catalog and on the website of the organizer. He/she also agrees with publishing pictures, results and critiques of his/her dog as much as needed by the organizer, the SKJ or partners of the show. The entry of a dog is financially binding.

Confirmation of the dog's admission to the show will be confirmed 5 days before the show by sending an entry letter to your email.

ENTRY FEES

The paid membership fee and paid membership in the club for this year are required for receiving an application in the amount of the membership fee.

Individuals registered to the minor puppy, puppy, veteran and honor classes are not considered as 1st registered dog.
